## Powered Industrial Truck Safety

<b>Overview</b>	As required by 29 CFR 1910.178, operators of Powered Industrial Trucks must complete a specific program of training (including formal instruction, practical training and an evaluation of performance). This course assists in meeting training requirements by providing principles and procedures involved in the safe operation of these vehicles.
<b>Learning Outcome</b>	At the completion of this course the student should understand the following as they apply to powered industrial trucks: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>? safety practices in preparing a truck for use</li><li>? principles of stability</li><li>? inspection protocol</li><li>? safe driving practices</li></ul>

<b>Target Audience</b>	Primary Audience: Potential operators of Powered Industrial Trucks, whether first-time users or experienced operators in need of a safety review.  Secondary Audience: Supervisors, company safety personnel, and maintenance personnel.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	No prerequisites are assigned to this course.
<b>System Requirements</b>	Any workstation that has a web browser with a Flash Plug-In and supports HTML 3.2 or above, such as Netscape Navigator 4.7 or higher (6.0 preferred) or Microsoft Internet Explorer 4.0 or higher (5.5 preferred), and a 33.6 Kbps or higher connection to the Internet. You will need to have Java enabled in your browser. The minimum supported screen resolution is 640x480, 256 colors. A resolution of 800x600 is recommended.
